SQUAD SWIMMER REGISTRATION FORM

Welcome to Raumati Swimming Club's squad training programme. Our coaches are Jim Floerchinger (Head Coach), Mike McNamara and Jason McPhee. Jim and Mike coach our two national squads, while Jason coaches the Bronze, Silver and Gold squads.

Please feel free to approach our coaches (either before or after training session) to arrange a time to have your swimmer assessed and placed in a squad.

Detailed below are the squads, the training times and fees, effective 1 April 2009.

Bronze	5-5.30pm; up to 2 sessions per week	\$169.00 per term
Silver	5-5.45pm; up to 3 sessions per week	\$184.00 per term
Gold	5-6pm; up to 4 sessions per week	\$189.00 per term
National Junior	5.30-7pm; 5 sessions per week	\$93.00 per month
National Senior	5-7pm; 5 sessions per week; plus two morning sessions	\$108.00 per month

Swimmers in Bronze, Silver and Gold squads can select which nights they will train, up to the number of sessions indicated. However, the coach must be informed and you must stick to those nights, so we can minimize any over-crowding in the lanes.

To register as a squad member, please complete all parts of these forms and place in the middle green box (on the wall next to lane 6 of the pool). Don't forget to include the name of the squad and indicate whether the enrolling swimmer will be a competitive swimmer. Fees for Bronze, Silver and Gold squads are billed at the start of each term, while national squad swimmers are billed at the beginning of each month.

The club expects all swimmers in gold squad and above to be competitive swimmers. Where spaces are at a premium, preference may be given to a 'competitive' swimmer, that is, a swimmer who regularly takes part in swimming competitions other than club race nights.

All squad swimmers are eligible to compete at club race nights and to enter the club championships. A condition of entry to race nights is parental involvement - this generally requires timekeeping (using a stopwatch). It is not difficult and we try to ensure race nights are finished by 8.30 at the latest. It is also a great way to meet other parents and learn more about competitive swimming.

It is a condition of membership that at least one parent of all competitive swimmers makes themselves available to assist at swim meets. This may be either meets run by the club or other meets at which the club is obliged to provide officials and may range from helping in the kitchen through to training as a pool official.

The club requires all new members to sign a code of conduct form. The attached form should be read and signed by both the swimmer and parent/caregiver. This copy will be

kept on file by the club, however a copy of the code of conduct can be found on the club website for future reference.

We also remind all parents/caregivers that they are responsible for their child's safety before/after training sessions or other club events. It is a real safety concern to see children waiting outside, often after dark, to be collected.
